

Transient Visitors February 2023 Illustration Contest Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

Contest is open to all people living in the United States of America. No entry fee is required. All rights to the entry become the property of David O'Boyle.

Requirements

- Contest is free to enter.
- Artist must be the sole author and the owner of the copyright for all art entered
- Artwork is limited to one entry per person.
- Artwork should be submitted as a high resolution (e.g. minimum of 2,400 pixels by 2,400 pixels) image of the artist's original artwork.
- Each file must be under 5 Megabytes in size.
- Artwork must be submitted in .jpg or .png format.
- Art can represent the following mediums: drawing and painting (i.e., *pencil, charcoal, pastels, colored pencils, oil paints, acrylics, water media, mixed media/collage*) and original digital creations.

Criteria

Entries will be evaluated based on *originality, interpretation* of subject matter/theme, *creative techniques, composition*, and overall art *appearance*.

Judging

David O'Boyle is the sole judge. David O'Boyle will make selections based on the above-mentioned criteria to determine which piece wins the contest.

Award

One winner will be selected from all entries. **The prize money for winning this contest is \$100.** The winner will be individually notified by email. Then the winner will be announced on <https://davidoboyles.com/>.

Submitting Entries

The Art Contest submission period begins February 3, 2023 and concludes on February 21, 2023 at midnight EST. Entries must be submitted by email to davidoboyles@gmail.com. The email header in the submission email should state "Transient Visitors_Ghostkeepers [first name last name, I

AGREE]”. **In the body of the email, please also copy and paste the below terms and conditions, which you agree indicates your CONSENT to the contest terms and conditions.**
